INTENSIVE SOYBEAN MANAGEMENT WORKSHOPS



The KY Soybean Board will be sponsoring two "Intensive Soybean Workshops, in the area. The first will be January 15th, the day before the Ky Commodity Conference, at the Sloan Convention Center. The program will begin at 11:30 a.m., with registration. Lunch will be provided and the program will conclude at 4:30 p.m.

Mr. Jeff Kazin, co-founder of Agris Academy. Agris Academy provides education opportunities to farmers that give them the skill to merchandise, manage risk, and increase the profitability of their production. Agris Academy is not a broker or advisor, but rather educate in risk management.
